

Substance abuse is one of the top public health issues in the U.S. today

100,000

medical professionals have a substance or alcohol abuse problem in any given year

69%

of doctors in 2013 reported that they abused prescription medicine to relieve stress and physical or emotional



MORE THAN 75%

of physicians have remarkable abstinence rates after completing an addiction/rehabilitation program.

Characteristics of substance abuse

- Withdrawal from social setting with colleagues
- Decreased performance at work
- Increased anxiety, defensiveness, or disruptive behaviors
- Deterioration in appearance or physical health
- Apathy toward patient care

How to help colleagues with SUDs

- Be alert of conditions and behaviors that may signal substance abuse disorder in colleagues
- Share concerns, show support, and express positive regards instead of accusation and blame
- Present facts about the physician's behavior in a way that lessens denial and encourages treatment
